Standardized Patients (SPs) are diverse people from our local community who are trained to work with students studying in health care professions.

SPs will:

- ✓ Act out real life scenarios based on actual patient cases.
- ✓ Meet students along with their faculty mentor and accurately represent a medical patient with various symptoms and complaints.
- ✓ Participate in simulated office visits where students ask medical history questions and/or conduct basic, non-invasive physical exams.
- ✓ Evaluate the students' performance in the medical interview, physical examination, diagnoses, and presenting patient information skills.

*SPs are not required to have a pre-existing medical condition.
SPs need to have a flexible schedule and reliable transportation.
SPs are selected for work based on availability and program need.*
